Sports Netting Installation in Florida

Gorilla Netting was born in Florida. We know the environment and what netting works best in extreme weather conditions. The UV exposure, the humidity, the hurricanes, the salt air — we deal with it every day, and we engineer every Florida system to handle it.

Why Florida Is Different

Florida is one of the most demanding environments for outdoor netting in the country. UV index regularly exceeds 10. Salt air accelerates corrosion on hardware and fittings. Afternoon thunderstorms are daily events for half the year. Hurricane-force winds are a real engineering consideration, not a footnote.

A netting system installed without Florida-specific engineering considerations will fail prematurely. Gorilla Netting has the field experience to specify and build systems that last in this environment.

Best Netting Materials for Florida's Climate

For outdoor netting in Florida, the right material matters significantly.

- **Nylon (UV-treated or tarred)** — High tensile strength, excellent impact absorption. Our primary outdoor netting material when properly coated for UV resistance.
- **Polyester** — Good inherent UV resistance, minimal water absorption, reliable in large outdoor systems. Excellent for driving ranges, sports fields, and golf course barriers.
- **Dyneema / UHMWPE** — Premium option immune to UV and water. Thin profile, near-invisible, 15-year warranties available. Best ROI for premium facilities in high-UV environments.

Gorilla Netting does not use HDPE for outdoor netting installations in Florida or anywhere else. Untreated nylon should not be used outdoors in Florida without UV coating or tarring.

Hurricane Engineering

Every Florida netting system Gorilla Netting designs is engineered to local wind-load requirements. In coastal zones and hurricane-prone areas, that means heavier pole sizing, deeper foundations, and cable specifications that account for sustained high winds.

Our breakaway netting systems are particularly valuable in Florida. When a hurricane hits, breakaway panels detach safely rather than pulling down poles and cables. After the storm passes, the panels are re-hung. The structural system — which is the expensive part — survives intact.

For Florida facilities, this is not a nice-to-have. It is the difference between the cost of re-hanging panels vs. a long-term shutdown to reorder and rebuild a partial or full netting system collapse.
